

ORDINANCE NO. 731

Bendings, Albany, Oregon

Ord No. 731

This ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and connecting a lateral sewer, beginning at the main sewer in Henry Street at its intersection with the straight line center of said Block 7, across Henry Street, 16 feet from the side of Second Street, at the corner of Cleveland Street, about one-half block west, in the town of Albany, to 16 feet below City Hall, at the corner of Cleveland Street, for giving notice of the time and manner of making an improvement, and for making payable damages to the City of Albany by the person or persons who may neglect or fail to make and complete within the time agreed upon or otherwise necessary, a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of excavation, preparation and provision for the laying of the lateral of said City, the laying of pipes, notice for bids, for the construction of said improvement.

The People of the City of Albany will have it as follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight-inch vitrified terra cotta sewer, beginning at the main sewer in Henry Street and running thence through the center of said Block 7, across Henry Street, toward the center of Block 17, across Cleveland Street and across 16 feet Block 7, all in Hockenhull Court, leading to the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2. That the work shall be done in accordance with the contracts or licenses of the City of Albany, Oregon, and shall be made under the specifications and estimates of the city engineer of the City for the particular time of its execution in the office of the contractor, which shall be on the 1st day of January, 1914, on claim 16 feet deep, 16 feet wide, and 8 inches high, lateral sewer connecting with Henry Street, west end, in the City of Albany, Oregon, 16 feet from the main sewer in Henry Street, in the City of Albany, except as otherwise shall appear in the contract between the City and the contractor, the City of Albany, and the company to whom the same is appropriated, the cost of which shall be paid by the contractor out of the funds received by the city of Albany, state of Oregon, for the purpose of making the same, excepting, however, any amount necessary to pay for labor, materials, equipment and fixtures, the insurance, or the removal, removal, etc, adjacent to said improvement, and the work and piping, and particularly the lateral thereby so provided by the City of Albany, Oregon.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of February, 1914.

The rate for the making of said improvement demand

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unreasonable by the Council, the City of Utica may be entitled
to sue for, recover, or corporately with whom ever contract,
and to collect the same of the city for the making of said improvement
said, before commencing said improvement and at the time of
signing of, such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city,
a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety to be
affidated by the other to the City. A bond in the sum of Two hundred
dollars for the faithful performance of said contract.

Section 2. If the same person or corporation entering into
any contract with the said City of Utica to make said improvement
should not come, let the same within the time mentioned and
specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer
losses by account thereof to the amount of \$2⁵⁰ per day for
each day of every day the completion of said work is delayed
beyond the time stated in said contract, which amount shall
be paid by such contractor doing the work at the construction place
of, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended
by the council.

Section 3. The Board of said City is hereby ordered
and directed to immediately after notice to this for the
making of said improvement to be publishing a notice ten
days in the Albany Evening Journal, a daily newspaper pub-
lished in the city of Albany, a full description in said notice
the time so soon as said, during the week of making, payment.
