Ord No. 733

An ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer, which the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 12 adopted by the council on the 13th day of May, 1914, beginning at the main sewer in Grant Street and running westerly through the center of said Block 17 across Grant Street, through the center of Block 14, across Commercial Street and 48 feet into Block 7, to ascertain, as aforesaid, and determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such sewer in assessment that is assessed upon each lot as so situated, and to direct the City Engineer to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessments in the books of said City as provided by the Charter of said City.

Whereas on the 12th day of April, 1914, the council of the City of Albany, Oregon, adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the construction of a lateral sewer beginning at the main sewer in Grant Street and running westerly through the center of said Block 17 across Grant Street, through the center of Block 14, across Commercial Street and 48 feet into Block 7, in the Block 7 tract a subdivision and to estimate the work to be done and the probable cost thereof and requiring such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost to be filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 13th day of May, 1914, and said resolution being and is a resolution No. 12 adopted by the council on the 13th day of May, 1914;

Whereas the City Engineer of said City of Albany, Oregon, pursuant to said resolution has made such plans, specifications and estimates as required by said resolution for the construction of said sewer in the manner specified in said resolution No. 12, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 13th day of May, 1914;

Whereas the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 13th day of May, 1914, by Resolution No. 12, has authorized the City Engineer and Recorder of said City to proceed to construct said lateral sewer beginning at the main sewer in Grant Street and running westerly through the center of said Block 17 across Grant Street, through the center of Block 14, across Commercial Street and 48 feet into Block 7, in the Block 7 tract a subdivision of the City of Albany, Oregon, as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany, Oregon, and

direction of the council of said City of Albany did duly see and
of said proposed improvement in the manner provided by the
charter of said city; and

Whereas the said council in and by said resolution
No. 12 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of
making said improvement to be paid by the owners of the real
property adjacent to said improvement as mentioned in said
resolution No. 12 to be the sum of \$547.21 and the total pro-
bable cost of making said improvement to be \$692.11

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as follows

Section 1. That an eight in a satisfied terra cotta water
main shall be laid beginning at the main sewer in rear of
said running westerly through the center of said Block 4 across
Lemon street, thence on the center of Block 4, across of 1/2 strand street
and 4 1/2 inch block in the northern front of Block 4
in the City of Albany, Oregon.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 12 and
the plans and specifications of said improvement filed by the
City Engineer with the records of said City of Albany, on the 13th
day of July, 1914.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said
improvement in the manner heretofore determined by the council
of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 12 is hereby
declared to be the sum of \$692.11 and the probable cost of said im-
provement to be paid by the respective owners and occupants and
particularly the following is the sum of \$547.21.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said
probable cost of said improvement shall be paid upon each lot
part thereof adjacent to said improvement as follows and
as determined by the council in and by said Resolution
No. 12 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the amount
and placed in the table hereto in accordance with the description of
each of said lots as follows:

Block 4, 1/2 strand street, Albany, Oregon
