An ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvement which the council of the City of Albany, Oregon has determined by Resolution No. 27, adopted by said council on the 5th day of August, 1914, to make on Ferry Street from the South line of Twelfth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of said improvement of said Ferry Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof a tenant to said part of Ferry Street to make improvements to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Assessment Books as provided by the charter of said City.

Whereas on the 22nd day of July 1914 the council of the City of Albany, Oregon adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Ferry Street from the South line of Twelfth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street, in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street, full width, with asphaltic concrete pavement.
- Third: By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete manholes.
- Fourth: By constructing cast iron drains.
- Fifth: By concrete curb stone inlets.
- Sixth: By laying, "Kefid" sewer pipe.

and so the estimated to be done on the said portion of Ferry Street, among the probable cost of said resolution that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable costs to be used in the recording office of said City, will remain being enclosed hereto and thereto attached the 22nd day of July, 1914 and

Whereas, the City Engineer of the City of Albany, pursuant to said resolution made on the 22nd day of July, 1914, specifications and estimates as described above, to be executed for the improvement of said Ferry Street in the manner specified in said resolution No. 27 and paved said street, plain, specifications and estimates in the recorder's office in said City on the 22nd day of August, 1914.

Whereas, it was deemed on the 5th day of August, 1914 by Resolution No. 27, then adopted by said Council determined and re-estimated that it is deemed fit expedient and that said engineer proposed to improve said street over said south line to Twelfth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 27, and

Whereas in said resolution No. 27, adopted on

Whereas, by the council, the records of said City were duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Ferry Street from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street as provided by the charter of said City of Albany; and

Whereas, the recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City of Albany, did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Ferry Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and,

Whereas, the said council in and by said Resolution No. 207, censured and voted, that the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Ferry Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said street, said Ferry Street is to be improved as mentioned in said Resolution No. 207 to the sum of \$4,181.06.

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street shall be improved as follows:

- First. By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
- Second. By paving the roadway of said street, all width with one intersection with Asphaltic Concrete pavement.
- Third. By laying and constructing Asphaltic Concrete drains.
- Fourth. By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth. By construction of inlets.
- Sixth. By laying artificial sewer pipe.

All in accordance with said resolution No. 207 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the records of said City of Albany on the 12th day of August, 1914.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street in the manner hereinbefore determined by the council of the said City of Albany in and by said resolution No. 207 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Ferry Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$4,181.06.

whereas by the council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Ferry Street, from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street as provided by the charter of said City of Albany; and

Whereas, the Recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Ferry Street in the manner provided by the charter of said city; and,

Whereas, the said council in and by said Resolution No. 27, contained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Ferry Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said street, of said Ferry Street to amount to one hundred and twenty five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to be paid in and by the sum of \$4,181.06.

Therefore,

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, grow the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street and improvements as follows:

- First. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second. By making the roadway of said street full width with all intersections with asphaltic concrete pavement.
- Third. By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete paving.
- Fourth. By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth. By constructing inlets.
- Sixth. By laying a triple sewer pipe.

All in accordance with said resolution No. 27 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Clerk of said City of Albany on the 2nd day of August, 1914.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street in the manner hereinabove determined by the council of the said City of Albany in and by said resolution No. 27 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Ferry Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$4,181.06.
