

be sufficient to ascertain and determine the probable cost of construction of a sewer from the boundary of the City of Albany, Oregon, near determined by the resolution No. 1, adopted by the Council on the 27th day, April, 1905, and approved by the Mayor on the 26th day, 1905, and running in the main line in Oak Street to brick sewer, main sewer, about one-half brick thick, and running thence Easterly across the rock, across Oak Street, and thence into Block 2, all in the manner's and manner's addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and to ascertain, assess, determine and fix the proportionate share of such probable cost, and to collect the same, but it is assessed upon each lot, upon its tier, in proportion to its value, to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement to such assessment in the Book of Assessments as provided under Chapter of said City.

Whereas, the City Engineer in pursuance of the directions of the Council of the City, has made plans, specifications and estimates of the construction of a new sewer lateral sewer, and fixed said plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder of the City, attorney, on the 8th day of April, 1905; and

Whereas, the Council of the City, by which, was, by Resolution No. 11, duly adopted by the Council, determined and resolved that it deem fit expenses and that said Council proposed to construct the above described lateral sewer; and

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 11, adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the City Engineer was directed and directed the City Engineer to give notice of said proposed improvement as provided by the Charter of the City of Albany; and

Whereas, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of the City, gave notice of said proposed improvement as provided by the Charter of the City; and

Whereas, the engineer calculated by said Resolution No. 11, estimated a lateral line of the brickable cost of making said improvement to be paid by the owners of real property adjacent to said improvement at the rate of \$100 per linear foot, to the sum of \$289.74, and the total brickable cost of making said improvement to be \$329.58.

Wherefore

the People of the City of Albany do enact as follows:

Section 1. That a eight inch vitrified terra cotta lateral sewer, made of brick sewer, at the main line Oak Street built up, and laid below the street in front of Block 2, and running

thence easterly across Block 1, across Rose Street, and 168 feet into Block 2, all in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, in accordance with said plans and specifications of said improvements filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of the City of Albany, on the 8th day of April, 1914.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution, is hereto declared to be the sum of \$327.50, and the probable cost of said improvement to be borne by the property adjacent and especially and particularly benefited thereby is the sum of \$289.74.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot or part thereof, adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 11 is hereto ascertained and determined to be the same set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof, as follows:
