

and authority to ascertain and determine the probable cost of construction of a lateral sewer under the Council of the City of Astoria, Oregon, now determined by Resolution No. 11, adopted by the Council on the 25th day of March, 1915, and approved in the Mayor on the 26th day of March, 1915, and in pursuance of the same to lay out and construct a sewer, and running thence Easterly across 10th St., across 11th St., and into Block 2, all in the Curran's Second and Third Lots to the City of Astoria, Oregon, and to ascertain, assess, determine and lay out the proportionate to care of such work on each lot, and to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Pocket of City Records as provided in the Charter of said City.

Whereas, the City Engineer in pursuance of the directions of the Council of the City of Astoria, Oregon, made plans, specifications and estimates for the construction of a new lateral sewer, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder of the City of Astoria, Oregon, on the 8th day of April, 1915, and

Whereas, the Council of the City of Astoria, Oregon, by Resolution No. 11, duly adopted on the 25th day of March, 1915, determined and resolved that it deem it expedient and that said Council proposed to construct the above described lateral sewer; and

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 11, adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by the Council to give notice of said proposed improvement as provided in the Charter of the City of Astoria, Oregon; and

Whereas, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of the City of Astoria, Oregon, has duly given notice of said proposed improvement as the same is required by the Charter of said City; and

Whereas, the City Engineer in pursuance of said Resolution No. 11, has ascertained and determined that the probable cost of making said improvement to be paid by the owners of real property adjacent to the said improvement as mentioned in said Resolution No. 11 to be the sum of \$289.74, and that the total probable cost of making said improvement to be \$329.58.

Therefore

the People of the City of Astoria do hereby resolve:

Section 1. That a right in and vitrified terra cotta lateral sewer under the said acquisition at the north side of Oak Street and thence running thence Easterly across 10th St., across 11th St., and into Block 2, all in the Curran's Second and Third Lots to the City of Astoria, Oregon, and to ascertain, assess, determine and lay out the proportionate to care of such work on each lot, and to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Pocket of City Records as provided in the Charter of said City.

Lawings, Albany, Oregon

thence easterly across Block 1, across Pine Street, and 168 feet into Block 2, all in Hackleman's Woodland Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, in accordance with said plans and specifications of said improvement, were filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 8th day of April, 1914.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution is hereby declared to be the sum of \$327.50, and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the property adjacent and especially and particularly benefited thereon is the sum of \$289.74.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 11 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the same set out and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof, as follows:
