

Lawyer: Albany, Oregon

That the said Council, authorized, the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with the Board of P. H. Junkin, of the Willamette and construct a lateral sewer, in accordance with the plan in Book 1, at the town of Albany, between and with an 8" pipe, and running in a straight line across Block 1, across Pine Street, and 68 feet into Block 2, a city sewer, in accordance with the plan in Book 1, at the town of Albany, with vitrified terra cotta sewer pipe according to the plans, specifications and notices filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 27th day of April, 1914.

That the said Council, on the 27th day of April, 1915, it was ordered that the above described lateral sewer be constructed, said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans, specifications and notes of the City Engineer thereon filed with the Recorder of the City of Albany, and

Whereas, it was provided by ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice of said improvement to the owners of the property in the manner provided by law and by official ordinance; and

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement, as provided and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to said ordinance, on the 27th day of April, 1915, the Board of P. H. Junkin, as set forth in the ordinance, did not appear to make any improvement, which was made in due form and in accordance with all the conditions imposed by law and ordinance, and it is said and ordered that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany be and they are authorized to enter into a contract with the Board of P. H. Junkin for the construction of the above described lateral sewer in the manner, manner and

Whereas, the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany were authorized by ordinance to enter into a contract with the Board of P. H. Junkin, as set forth in the ordinance, and

That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany be and they are authorized to enter into a contract with the Board of P. H. Junkin, as set forth in the ordinance, and

That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany be and they are authorized to enter into a contract with the Board of P. H. Junkin, as set forth in the ordinance, and

Section 4. That the said City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Board of P. H. Junkin, as set forth in the ordinance, and

in said or his cease, advertisement and bid hereinafter mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of July, 1915; and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damage to the extent of \$2.50 per day for each day every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time.

Said contract shall further provide that the said W. B. Weaver and G. M. Jenkins shall, promptly, as due, make payment to all persons supplying to the said W. B. Weaver and G. M. Jenkins labor or material for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work and that the said W. B. Weaver and G. M. Jenkins shall not permit any claim or claim to be filed or prosecuted against the City of Albany for or on account of any material or labor furnished for the said work.

The said W. B. Weaver and G. M. Jenkins shall furnish a penal bond in the sum of \$175.00, with good and sufficient sureties to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, to secure the faithful performance of the obligations herein contract on the part of said W. B. Weaver and G. M. Jenkins and to indemnify against loss, injury or claim for labor, work or material on the part of any person arising out of said contract.
