

We the Councilmen and Mayor and Recorder of the City of G. Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with W. B. Neaves, a building and constructing ten feet in diameter sewer tributary to the Cottage Street trunk sewer, with a trifid tee, a cottae sewer pipe according to the plans, specifications and profile filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of G. Albany on the 13th day of October, 1915.

Whereas, by Resolution No. 1, passed by the Council of the City of G. Albany on the 14th day of October, 1915, it was ordered that the following described lateral sewer be constructed in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of G. Albany and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of G. Albany, to-wit:

No. 1. Beginning at the Cottage Street trunk sewer manhole between Seventh and Eighth Streets and running thence easterly through the center of Block 1 of City View Addition and through the center of Block 1 of Mountain View Addition, a distance of 336 feet.

No. 2. Beginning at the Cottage Street trunk sewer manhole between Eighth and Ninth Streets and running thence easterly through the center of Block 1 of City View Addition and through the center of Block 1 of Mountain View Addition, a distance of 386 feet.

No. 3. Beginning at the Cottage Street trunk sewer manhole between Ninth and Tenth Streets and running thence easterly through the center of Block 12 of City View Addition, through the center of Block 8 of Mountain View Addition, through the center of Block 6 of Mountain View Addition, across Union Street and through the center of Block 5 of Heights Addition, a distance of 804 feet.

No. 4. Beginning at the Cottage Street trunk sewer manhole between Tenth and Union Street and running thence easterly through the center of Block 12 of City View Addition, through the center of Block 11 of Mountain View Addition, through the center of Block 5 of Heights Addition, across Union Street and through the center of Block 2 of Heights Addition, a distance of 801 feet.

No. 5. Beginning at the Cottag Street trunk sewer manhole between Cleary Street and Twelfth Street, running thence easterly through the center of Block 19 of City Line Addition, thence through the center of Block 18 of Mountain View Addition, through the center of Block 19 of City Line Addition, across Willamette Street, and thence through the center of Block 3 of Heights Addition, a distance of 544 feet, thence beginning at a manhole in said block, running in Willamette Street South, thence easterly along Willamette Street, across Twelfth Street, and to the center of Block 2 of Jeffersonite Church Addition, a distance of 276 feet, thence atery over the centerline of Block 2 and 1 of Phenixnite Church Addition, a distance of 267 feet.

No. 6. Beginning at the Cottag Street trunk sewer manhole between Twelfth and Klammath Streets, running thence easterly along the north boundary line of Phenixnite Addition a distance of 500 feet.

No. 7. Beginning at the Cottag Street trunk sewer manhole between Cleary Street and Willamette Street, running thence westerly through the center of Block 2 of City Line Addition, across Cleary Street, and through the center of Block 19 of City Line Addition, a distance of 414 feet.

No. 8. Beginning at the Cottag Street trunk sewer manhole between Cleary Street and Willamette Street, and running thence easterly along the south line of Block 19, across Cleary Street, through the center of Block 20, across Cleary Street, through the center of Block 21, across Cleary Street, a distance of 935 feet.

No. 9. Beginning at the Cottag Street trunk sewer manhole between Cleary Street and Willamette Street, running thence easterly through the center of Block 20 of City Line Addition, a distance of 283 feet.

No. 10. Beginning at the Cottag Street trunk sewer manhole between Ninth and 12th Streets, and running thence westerly through the center of Block 19 of City Line Addition, a distance of 102 feet.

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement, a bill was read given in the Record of the City of Albany according to said Resolution No. 1, M. G. Lawlor, on the 21st instant in 1913, for the following:

Council of the said City of Albany, in the for making certain improvements with vitrified terra cotta sewer pipe, which bill was made in due form and has conformity with all the conditions required by law and by said Resolution No. 31 by which said bill was filed, H. S. Weather proposed to furnish all material and iron elements and perform the labor necessary to build and construct the aforesaid described lateral sewers with vitrified terra cotta sewer pipe for the following named pieces, to wit:

Whereas, W. H. Ullman was the lowest and best bidder for said proposed improvement, vizt: vitrified terra cotta sewer pipe and culvert
which was the lowest and best bid for said improvements as a whole;

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany do claim as follows:

Section 1. That the said bid of said W. H. Ullman for said improvements with vitrified terra cotta sewer pipe to said the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said W. H. Ullman for the making of said improvements as aforesaid on behalf of the City of Albany. Whereupon, upon the terms and conditions in said ordinance, resolution is, a true instrument and will hereinafter mentioned. Said contract shall provide that the work on said sewer of all kinds commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of October 1870, so that the City of Albany, herein, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$1.00 per ton per each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time. Said contract shall further provide that the said W. H. Ullman shall promptly, as he, and be paid payment to all persons supplying to the said W. H. Ullman labor or material for the prosecution of the hereinabove described work and that the said W. H. Ullman shall not permit any lien or claims to be set up or prosecuted against the City of Albany for nonpayment of any material or labor furnished by him under said contract.

The said W. H. Ullman shall be paid a price bond in the sum of \$2,700.00, with year and sufficient security to be supplied by the Mayor of the City of Albany to secure the faithful performance of all the obligations of said contract on the part of said W. H. Ullman and particularly against any claim or lien for any work or material on the part of any person arising out of said contract.
