

ORDINANCE NO. 928

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (\$250.00) DOLLARS OF THE STREET FUND OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, IN PAYMENT OF THE BALANCE DUE ON HENDERSON MOTORCYCLE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the Street Fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$250.00) Dollars for the purpose of making payment of the balance due on Henderson Motorcycle, 1918 Model and number 2136H, for the use of traffic officers of said city.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant against the Street Fund of said City of Albany for the amount hereby appropriated and payable to Dayton Cycle Company, for the uses and purposes hereinabove set forth.
