

ORDINANCE NO. 233.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ALBANY TANNING COMPANY FOR THE SALE AND REMOVAL OF THE TWO STORY FRAME BUILDING LOCATED UPON BLOCK 29, OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany has heretofore determined by resolution that the two story frame building located upon Block 29 of the City of Albany, Oregon, is not needed for public use and that said property should be sold to the highest bidder for cash; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany, Albany Tanning Company presented to the Council of the City of Albany a bid for the purchase and removal of said building for the sum of \$351.00 which said bid was the highest and best bid for said purchase and removal of said building;

Section 1. That the bid of Albany Tanning Company for the purchase and removal of said two story frame building located on Block 29 of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said Albany Tanning Company for the sale ^{and removal} of said building upon the terms specified in said bid above mentioned.

Said contract shall provide that the work of the removal of said building shall commence within five days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that the said building shall be completely removed and all work embraced in said contract shall be completely performed on or before the first day of June, 1919, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$5.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the said Albany Tanning Company shall furnish a bond in the sum of \$200.00 Dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon conditioned for the faithful performance of the said contract on the part of said Albany Tanning Company and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or material on the part of any person, firm, or corporation arising out of said contract.

Section 2. Whereas, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany, that this ordinance shall become immediately operative an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
