AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 7 OF AN ORDINANCE RETITLED "AN ORDINANCE GREATING AND REGULATING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ALEANY," PASSED BY THE COUNCIL APRIL 22, 1914, AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR APRIL 26, 1914.

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY TO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 721, entitled "An Ordinance creating and regulating the Fire Department of the City of Albany," passed by the Council April 22, 1914, and approved by the Mayor April 25, 1914, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. The chief engineer, assistant engineer, engineman, auto driver, call men and other employees of the fire department shall receive such salaries as the Council may, from time to time, fix by resolution, provided, however, that no member of the fire department shall be entitled to additional compensation by reason of being assigned to different or additional duties from those of the position to which he was first appointed.
