

ORDINANCE NO. 981

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF IMPROVING SEVENTH STREET FROM THE EAST LINE OF MAIN STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF PINE STREET, PROVIDING HOW THE COST OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT SHALL BE PAID, THE PENALTY OR DAMAGES TO THE CITY OF ALBANY BY THE PERSON OR PERSONS MAKING SUCH IMPROVEMENT, IF THE SAME SHALL NOT BE COMPLETED WITHIN THE TIME AGREED UPON AND THE GIVING OF A GOOD AND SUFFICIENT BOND FOR THE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF THE WORK OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID PART OF SAID STREET, AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING BY THE RECORDER OF SAID CITY OF PROPER NOTICE FOR BIDS FOR THE COMPLETION OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT OF SAID PART OF SAID STREET.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Seventh Street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of Pine Street shall be improved in the following manner to-wit:

- First: By grading said street.
- Second: By graveling said street
- Third: By laying drain tile

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said city for the improvement of said street, filed in the office of the Recorder of said city of Albany, Oregon, on the 8th day of March, 1921, endorsed "Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of Seventh Street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of Pine Street and the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of Seventh Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessment hereafter to be made; ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said Seventh Street so to be improved, and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the Charter of said city.

The said improvement of said portion of said Seventh Street shall be completed by the 1st day of August, 1921

All the bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Seventh

Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to have suffered damages on account thereof to the amount of \$ 10.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said city is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said portion of said Seventh Street by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Democrat, a daily newspaper published in said City of Albany fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of such improvement of said Seventh Street.


