

ORDINANCE NO. 1002.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND RECORDERS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY OREGON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH L.O. HERROLD FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF EAST THIRD STREET FROM THE WEST CURB LINE OF RAILROAD STREET TO THE WEST LINE OF MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 996 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon to-wit: Third Street from the West curb line of Railroad Street to the West line of Main Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper sub-grade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation, or by paving said street with Portland cement concrete pavement or Warrenite bitulithic wearing surface pavement upon a bituminous concrete base, at the option of the Council.
- Third: By laying and constructing wooden headers.
- Fourth: By constructing concrete curb.
- Fifth: By constructing catch basins.
- Sixth: By constructing inlets.
- Seventh: By laying sewer pipes.
- Eighth: By laying sub-drain tile.
- Ninth: By constructing monument cases.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany and the amended plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the Ordinance last aforesaid; and

WHEREAS, the Council in and by Resolution No. 23 did adopt and select asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base as the most advantageous kind of pavement for making such improvement and, to-wit; on the 15th day of July, 1921 L.O. Herrold presented to the Council of the City of Albany its bid for making said improvement with asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base pavement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid L.O. Herrold proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base pavement for the following named prices, to-wit:

AND WHEREAS, said L.O.Herrold was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

Section 1. That the bid of L.O.Herrold for said improvement of said described portion of Third Street with Asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with L.O.Herrold for making said improvement with Asphaltic concrete upon a bituminous concrete base pavement on behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 15th day of September 1921, and the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$ 50.00 per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond said specified time, and that the L.O.Herrold furnished a bond in the sum of Twenty Five Thousand Dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as surety some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon or some person justifying in twice the amount of said bond, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of L.O.Herrold and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor or material on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.
