

ORDINANCE NO. 1041

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE Repealing Ordinance No. 1040 entitled
"An ordinance providing for the issuance of improvement bonds of the City
of Albany, Oregon, in the sum of \$33,802.69; providing and approving the
form of the bonds to be issued and the coupons attached thereto, providing
for the advertisement and sale of said bonds, and declaring an emergency"
passed by the Council on the 12th. day of April, 1922, and approved by the
Mayor on the 13th. day of April, 1922, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That Ordinance No. 1040 passed by the Council on the
12th. day of April, 1922, and approved by the Mayor on the 13th. day of
April, 1922, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section II. That inasmuch as it is necessary for the preservation
of the peace, good order and welfare of the City of Albany, Oregon, an
emergency is hereby declared and found to exist and this ordinance shall be
in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor of the
City of Albany.
