

ORDINANCE No. 1084

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE Authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon to enter into a contract with C. E. Davis for the improvement of Thurston Street from the North line of Ninth Street North to the South line of the Southern Pacific Railway company right of way in the city of Albany, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, By Ordinance No. 1085 of the City of Albany, Oregon, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit: Thurston Street from the North line of Ninth Street North to the South line of the Southern Pacific Railway company right of way, be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

1. By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
2. By graveling said street with gravel or crushed rock.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany the plans, specifications and estimates of Engineer J. R. Penland, then on file with the Recorder of the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, It was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

WHEREAS, After due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the Recorder of the City of Albany according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: on the 8th. day of August, 1923, C. E. Davis presented to the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, his bid for making said improvement with Gravel, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the Council, by which said bid C. E. Davis proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement with gravel, for the following named prices, to-wit:

Excavation, per cubic yd.	\$ .90
Fill per cubic yd.	.90
Gravel " " "	1.70

AND, WHEREAS, Said C. E. Davis, was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

Section 1. That the bid of C. E. Davis, for said improvement of said described portion of Thurston Street with Gravel be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in writing with the said C. E. Davis for the making of said improvement with gravel on behalf of the city of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms in said bid hereinabove mentioned.

Section 2. Said contract to provide further that the work of said improvement shall commence within ten days after the signing of said contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract
