ORDINANCE NO. 1109

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE relating to the posting of signs, bills, posters, or other advertising matter on buildings, posts, trees or other premises in the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof and repealing Ordinance No. 889, entitled "An Ordinance relating to the posting of signs, bills, posters or other advertising matter on buildings, posts, trees or other premises in the City of Albany, Oregon." passed by the Council, May 9, 1917, and approved by the Mayor May 9, 1917;"

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to post any sign, bill, poster, or other advertising matter on any building, post, tree, fence or other premises in the City of Albany, Oregon, unless such person or persons shall have first obtained permission of the owner or person in control of such premises.

Section 2. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be fined not less than \$5.00 or more than \$10.00 or shall be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than two days nor more than five days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.
