

**ORDINANCE NO. 1197**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into a contract with the Seegrave Corporation for the purchase of one Triple Combination Gasoline Pumper and Hose cart for the use of the City of Albany, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, by virtue of Chapter 10 of the Charter of said City are authorized and directed to provide said City with adequate fire fighting equipment, vehicles, pumps, machines and supplies, and by ordinance to make selection of the kind and specifications of such apparatus, and to enter into an agreement with any firm, person or corporation for the purchase or other acquisition of the same.

AND WHEREAS, in order to provide said City with adequate fire protection the Council deems it expedient to provide said City with a Triple Combination Gasoline Pumper and Hose Cart, to make selection of the kind and specifications of such apparatus, and to enter into a contract for the purchase of the same.

AND WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that the Triple Combination Gasoline Pumper and Hose Cart manufactured by the Seegrave Corporation to be the most equipment for the present needs and uses of the City of Albany, Oregon;

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Seegrave Corporation for the purchase by said City from the Seegrave Corporation one Triple Combination Gasoline Pumper and Hose Cart, of the capacity of 1000 gallons per minute, with complete auxiliary apparatus, all for the use of said City of Albany, Oregon, said property to cost not more than Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred (\$13,500) Dollars, and said contract to provide that the same shall be paid for out of funds arising from the sale of an issue of bonds authorized for such purpose by the charter of the City of Albany.

Section 2. That in order that the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany may be preserved an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


