ORDINANCE NO. 1223

AN ORDINANCE regulating the traffic of motor vehicles in the city of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for violation thereof:

THE PROPILE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: --

Section 1. All motor vehicles actively in use in the enforcement of any taffic law, or ordinance, of the City of Albany, and all patrol wagons, ambulances, fire patrols, fire engines, and fire apparatus, shall in all cases, with due regard to the cafety of the public, and the efficient protection of property, have the right of way in and upon the streets and alleys of the City of Albany over any and all other vehicles.

Section 2. All vehicles upon any of the streets of the City of Albany shall, when being approached by any fire engine, fire patrol, or fire apparatus, immediately drive as far as possible to the right hand side of the street and step until such fire patrol, fire engine, or fire apparatus shall have passed by.

Section 3. The sound of a siren or bell emanating from an approaching motor vehicle, shall be prima facie evidence that such vehicle is then and there being operated as a patrol wagin, ambulance, fire patrol, fire engine, fire spparatus, or a traffic or police officer vehicle, and it shall be the duty of the driver of any motor vehicle when such siren shall be sounded within his hearing, to immediately drive to the right of the street upon which he is then moving, and stop until such vehicle shall have passed by.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court, be fined in a sum not more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not to exceed twelve days, or upon default in the payment of such fine that he be imprisoned in the City Jail for the period of one day for each \$2.00 of fine impresed, or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Court.
