

## ORDINANCE NO. 1333

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$252.76 of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, for the purpose of making part payment on purchase price of four tires and four tubes for the Fire Department of said City and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, the Council has deemed it expedient to purchase new tires and tubes for the Fire Department Seagrave Pumper and has agreed with Tedlock and Forester for the purchase of said tires; and whereas, the said Tedlock & Forester have agreed to take the old tires and tubes on said pumper as a part payment and the sum of \$252.76 cash for the set of new tires and tubes, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated of the General Funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$252.76 for the purpose of making part payment on purchase price of four automobile tires and four tubes for the use of the Fire Department of said City.

Section 2. That the Recorder be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant drawn on the general funds of said City in the sum of \$252.76, payable to Tedlock & Forester in part payment of the purchase price of the tires and tubes mentioned in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany require that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
