

ORDINANCE No. 1393

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of Five Hundred Seventy-three and 85/100 (\$573.85) Dollars, to be paid to Hurley's Plumbing Shop in payment of the cost of re-roofing the City Hall building of the City of Albany and authorizing the Recorder to draw a warrant against the general fund of said City in payment of the amount herein appropriated and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany the sum of Five Hundred Seventy-three and 85/100 (\$573.85) Dollars in payment of the cost of re-roofing the City Hall Building of the City of Albany and the Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver to Hurley's Plumbing Shop the General fund warrant of said City in the amount and for the purpose hereby appropriated.

Section 2. In as much as the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in immediate force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
