

ORDINANCE NO. 1400

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$525.00 of the Street Fund of the City of Albany for the purchase of one Chevrolet pick-up automobile from the Albany Auto Company, and authorizing the Recorder to execute and deliver a warrant against said fund in said amount and for said purpose.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There shall be and is hereby appropriated from the Street Fund of the City of Albany the sum of \$525.00 for the purchase of one Chevrolet pick-up automobile from the Albany Auto Company, and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to said Albany Auto Company a warrant against the Street Fund of said city for said amount and for said purpose upon the proper presentation to and allowance by the Council of the claim therefor.

Section 2. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
