Whereas, The fire apparatus of the fire department of the city of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, is kept in the City Hall Building, which is situated on the South Side of Second Street, between Broadalbin Street and Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and

Whereas, The parking of vehicles and the manner in which they are parked is of vital concern to the efficient operation of the fire department of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and

Whereas, the ingress and egress to said City Hall Building is impaired by the parking of automobiles near the entrance to the City Hall Building wherein the said fire apparatus is kept," passed by the common council of said city on December 28, 1923, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 283. That Ordinance No. 1111, entitled "A bill for an ordinance to license and regulate hawkers and peddlers in the City of Albany, Oregon, and defining what shall constitute a hawker and a peddler and providing a penalty for the violation thereof, and repealing Ordinance No. 593, entitled 'An ordinance to license and regulate hawkers and peddlers within the City of Albany, Oregon, and defining what shall constitute a hawker and a peddler and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith" passed by the Council on June 26th, 1912 and approved by the mayor on June 26th, 1912" and declaring an emergency," passed by the common council of said city on December 28, 1923, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 1506

Section 284. That Ordinance No. 1174, entitled "An ordinance to prohibit the driving, running or operating of any automobile, truck, motorcycle or any other motor vehicle while in an intoxicated condition or under the influence of intoxicating liquor, and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the common council of said city on April 22, 1925, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 285. That Ordinance No. 1176, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the parking of motor vehicles within the City of Albany, Oregon, and to provide a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the common council of said city on April 22, 1925, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 286. That Ordinance No. 1215, entitled "An ordinance to amend Section 5 of Ordinance No. 948, of the City of Albany, Oregon, entitled 'An ordinance regulating the traffice of vehicles in the City of Albany, and providing a penalty for violation thereof and declaring an emergency,' passed by the council July 19, 1919, and approved by the mayor July 10, 1919, and declaring an emergency," passed by the common council of said city on October 28, 1925, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 287. That Ordinance No. 1223, entitled "An ordinance regulating the traffic of motor vehicles in the city of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for violation thereof," passed by the common council of said city on March 10, 1926, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 288. That Ordinance No. 1246, entitled "An ordinance regulating the traffic of motor vehicles in the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for violation thereof," passed by the common council of said city on April 27, 1927, and approved by the mayor on May 2, 1927, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 289. That Ordinance No. 1257, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the use of vehicle traffic upon Second Street in the City of Albany, Oregon; providing a penalty for violation hereof, and declaring an emergency," passed by the common council of said city on July 27, 1927, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 290. That Ordinance No. 1260, entitled "An ordinance to amend Section 4 of Ordinance No. 948, entitled 'An ordinance regulating the traffic of vehicles in the City of Albany, and providing a penalty for violation thereof and declaring an emergency,' passed by the Council July 9, 1919, and approved by the mayor July 10, 1919," passed by the common council of said city on September 14, 1927, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 291. That Ordinance No. 1261, entitled "An ordinance to amend Section 4 of Ordinance Number 948, entitled 'An ordinance regulating the traffic of vehicles in the City of Albany and providing a penalty for violation thereof, and declaring an emergency,' passed by the council July 9th, 1919, and approved by the Mayor July 10th, 1919, as amended by Ordinance No. 1260, passed by the Council September 14th, 1927, and approved by the Mayor September 14th, 1927," passed by the common council of said city on September 28, 1927, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 292. That Ordinance No. 1267, entitled "An ordinance to prohibit the parking of motor vehicles adjacent to certain portions of the United States Post Office property in the City of Albany, and providing for a penalty for violation thereof," passed by the common council of said city on December 28, 1927, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 293. That Ordinance No. 1319, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the traffic of motor vehicles in the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing for a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the common council of said city on June 26, 1929, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 294. That Ordinance No. 1325, entitled "An ordinance regulating the traffic of motor vehicles within the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for violation thereof," passed by the common council of said city on November 13, 1929, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 295. That Ordinance No. 1332, entitled "An ordinance requiring all persons, firms and corporations operating urban passenger busses upon and along the streets, avenues, thoroughfares and public highways on a time schedule and over fixed termini, within the limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, to first obtain a franchise from said city for such purpose, and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the common council of said city on October 8, 1930, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be and the same is hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 1506.

Section 296. That Ordinance No. 1343, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the motor vehicle traffic upon the streets of the City of Albany, to provide for the establishment of safety zones upon such streets, the regulation of automobile traffic therein, and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the common council of said city on February 11, 1931, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 297. That Ordinance No. 1354, entitled "An ordinance regulating the parking of motor vehicles upon the public streets of the City of Albany in front of the main entrance of public theater buildings and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the common council of said city on December 23, 1931, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 298. That Ordinance No. 1365, entitled "An ordinance prohibiting the owners, lessees, proprietors or employees of public billiard rooms and public pool rooms from permitting minors under the age of eighteen years to engage in any games therein or to loiter therein and providing penalties for violation of the provisions of this ordinance and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances conflicting herewith," passed by the common council of said city on July 13, 1932, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 299. That Ordinance No. 1371, entitled "An ordinance to license tax, regulate and restrain the manufacture, sale and/or disposal of alcoholic beverages within the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, defining what shall constitute alcoholic beverages; prohibiting the manufacture sale and/or disposal thereof without a license; providing a penalty for violation thereof, and declaring an emergency," passed by the common council of said city on April 12, 1933, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 300. That Ordinance No. 1375, entitled "An ordinance to amend Sections 6 and 7 of Ordinance No. 1371, of the City of Albany, Oregon, entitled 'An ordinance to license, tax, regulate and restrain, the manufacture, sale, and/or disposal of alcoholic beverages within the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; defining what shall constitute alcoholic beverages; prohibiting the manufacture, sale and/or disposal thereof without a license; providing a penalty for violation hereof and declaring an emergency,' passed by the council April 12, 1933, and approved by the Mayor April 12, 1933," passed by the common council of said city on June 14, 1933, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 301. That Ordinance No. 1376, entitled "An ordinance to amend Section 10 of Ordinance No. 1371, of the City of Albany, entitled 'An ordinance to license, tax, regulate and restrain, the manufacture, sale and/or disposal of alcoholic beverages within the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; defining what shall constitute alcoholic beverages; prohibiting the manufacture, sale and/or disposal thereof without a license, providing a penalty for violation hereof and declaring an emergency,' passed by the Council April 12, 1933, and approved by the Mayor April 12, 1933," passed by the common council of said City on July, 26, 1933, and approved by the mayor on the same day, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Section 302. That Ordinance No. 1406, entitled "An ordinance regulating the use of the streets and alleys of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the parking of motor vehicles and other implements thereon and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed by the common council of said city on August 12, 1936, and approved by the mayor on August 15, 1936, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.


