

ORDINANCE NO. 1536

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$772.84 from the General Funds of the City of Albany in payment of the purchase price of one Ford DeLux Tudor sedan and accessories for the use of the Police Department of said City and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$772.84 for the purpose of purchasing one 1941 Ford DeLux Tudor Sedan and accessories for the use of the Police Department of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver a General Fund Warrant in the sum of \$772.84 payable to Nissen Motor Company in payment of the purchase price of said automobile and accessories heretofore ordered in connection therewith.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health, and safety of the People of the City of Albany is involved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the council and approval of the Mayor.
