

ORDINANCE NO. 1548

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$1217.48 of the general fund of the City of Albany for the purpose of purchasing of Nelson Equipment Company three 7 1/2 Horse power Cam sirens for air raid alarm defense purposes, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$1217.48 for the purpose of purchasing from Nelson Equipment Company three 7 1/2 Horse power Cam sirens for air raid alarm defenses purposes.

Section 2. The Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant against the general fund chargeable to the amount hereby appropriated as emergency fund, payable to Nelson Equipment Company in the sum hereinabove appropriated and to deliver the same to the payee.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involved and whereas, an emergency exists, therefore this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
