

ORDINANCE NO. 1676

## A Bill For:

An Ordinance designating the name of that certain street, formerly County road, beginning at the North line of A street in the City of Albany, Oregon at its intersection with what is commonly known as Marion Street in Sunrise Addition to said city and running thence Northwesterly to the Northwest corner of Bacon Addition and thence Northerly to the Southern Pacific Company right-of-way.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That that certain street beginning at the North line of A Street in the City of Albany, Oregon at its intersection with what is commonly known as Marion Street in Sunrise Addition to said city and running thence Northwesterly to the northwest corner of Bacon Addition and thence Northerly to the Southern Pacific Company right-of-way; be and the same is hereby designated as Howard Drive.
