

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 1, of Ordinance #1596 entitled "AN ORDINANCE providing for the appointment of a Park and Recreation Commission for the City of Albany, Oregon, providing the terms of office of the members thereof and defining the powers and duties of said Commission," passed by the Council May 23, 1945 and approved by the Mayor May 24, 1945.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDEIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance #1596 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE providing for the appointment of a Parks and Recreation Commission for the City of Albany, Oregon, providing the terms of office of the members thereof and defining the powers and duties of said Commission," passed by the Council May 23, 1945 and approved by the Mayor May 24, 1945, be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon shall appoint a commission to be known as the Parks and Recreation Commission, consisting of seven members each of whom shall hold office during the pleasure of the Council. Three members of the Commission shall be those who are members of the City Council of said City and two members of the Commission shall be those who are members of the school board of School District #5. Two members of the Commission shall be appointed from the tax paying legal voters of the City of Albany, Ore. Each Commissioner shall qualify by subscribing to and filing his written oath of office in the office of the City Recorder, within five days after appointment.
