

ORDINANCE No. 1761

A Bill For:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1411 entitled "An Ordinance governing the installation and operation of stove or range oil burning equipments and the storage and handling of oil fuels in connection therewith and providing a penalty for violation thereof" passed by the Council October 28, 1936.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1411 entitled "An Ordinance governing the installation and operation of stove or range oil burning equipments and the storage and handling of oil fuels in connection therewith and providing a penalty for violation thereof" passed by the Council, October 28, 1936, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto sub-section (c).

Section 2. Sub-section (c). No certificate of approval shall be issued for any kind of oil burning equipment unless it has the Underwriters Laboratories Label attached or stamped upon the oil burning stove, heater, range, furnace, or such other heating equipment.
