ORDINANCE NO. 1948

A bill for:

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING NEW WORK, REPAIRS, LOWERING OR RAISING EXISTING LINES BY UTILITY CO.

Section 1. All street openings, made by any Utility Company, for repairing of leaks, raising or lowering in grade of existing lines, construction of new lines, or extensions of existing lines within the Limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be cleaned out after the work is performed and such openings shall be back-filled with suitable material to insure a minimum of settlement in the opening and at least 12" of the top of the backfilling shall consist of crusher run material which meets the approval of the City Engineer. The backfilling of such openings shall be performed in a workmanlike manner and where such openings entail the cutting or removing of hard surface material from the street thus opened, such backfilling shall be made as above described and shall be completed by resurfacing such opening with the same quality of hard surfacing material as was originally in existence at such opening.

Section 2. Before any work is started on extensions to existing lines, or construction of new lines, or the lowering of existing lines, or raising of existing lines, in the City of Albany, Oregon, the Utility Companies performing such work, shall submit a map and profile of such proposed work to the City Engineer, for approval of such work, and before any changes in the Original Map and Profile of such proposed work thus submitted, can be done, additional approval for such changes in the original proposed work shall be secured from the City Engineer. All such approval for any work above described shall be in writing.

Section 3. All openings mentioned above, shall be made and completed according to existing laws now in force within the City of Albany, pertaining to such work, and completion of this work shall be expedited by such Utility Companies to their best abilities. The City Engineer, or his representatives shall have the right to enter on the work and any violations of City requirements for such work, by the Utility Company performing this work, shall be called to such company's attention and full compliance shall be made by such company under the City Engineer's direction.
