

ORDINANCE NO. 2154

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 858 IN ITS ENTIRETY WHICH WAS PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR APRIL 12, 1916 PROVIDING FOR AUDITING OF THE BOOKS AND ACCOUNTS AND RECORDS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 858 which was passed by the council and approved by the Mayor April 12, 1916, providing for auditing of the books and accounts and records of the City of Albany, Oregon be repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Whereas the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
