

ORDINANCE NO. 2166

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon to enter into a contract with the North Albany Fire Protection District.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the North Albany Fire Protection District, which said contract shall be substantially in words and figures as follows:

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 1st day of July, 1949, by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, a municipal corporation, as first party, and North Albany Fire Protection District, a political subdivision, as second party,

WITNESSETH:

First party hereby agrees to furnish second party such fire fighting and fire prevention facilities as may be deemed to be reasonable by said first party without diminishing or limiting the present facilities of said first party within its own boundaries and that said services shall be furnished to second party for a period of twelve months beginning July 1, 1949 and continuing to June 30, 1950.

For said services the second party hereby promises and agrees to pay the first party the sum of \$1200.00 covering the twelve months herein specified and that said sum shall be paid to first party as and when the tax revenues shall have been turned over to the second party for said period by the County Treasurer of Benton County, Oregon.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed to require the first party to provide fire fighting facilities or man-power to the second party during any time while a conflagration may be in progress within the City of Albany.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have hereunto executed this agreement, in duplicate, by the duly authorized officers of the respective parties on the day and date first hereinabove written.
