

ORDINANCE NO. 2169

An ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 590 which is an Ordinance Regulating the Plumbing, Ventilation and Drainage of Buildings in the City of Albany, Oregon; Providing for the Appointment of an Inspector of Plumbing; Prescribing his Qualifications, Powers, Duties and Compensation; and Providing a Penalty for Violation thereof.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

That Paragraph 8 entitled "Rain Drains" of Section 5 of said Ordinance No. 590 be repealed and the following substituted therefor:

Rain Drains. No conductors of rainfall run-off shall be connected directly or indirectly with the existing sanitary or combined sewers except through the catch-basins installed upon the street by or under the direction of the City Engineer, except that in heavily built up areas where storm sewer construction is unlikely, the City Engineer may grant permission for the connection of rain drains to the existing combined sewers.
