ORDINANCE NO. 2170

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A JOINT AIRPORT ZONING BOARD, TO COOPERATE WITH THE COUNTY OF LINN, STATE OF OREGON, IN SUCH ZONING BOARD, TO GRANT SUCH BOARD POWER TO ADOPT, ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE AIRPORT ZONING REGULATIONS IN AND ABOUT THE CITY OF ALBANY AIRPORT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by virtue of Chapter 542, Oregon Laws 1947, certain powers were granted to municipalities to promulgate, administer and enforce airport zoning regulations;

WHEREAS, said law further provides that if such airport is located outside of the territorial limits of the municipality, then a joint Airport Zoning Board may be created with the County in which the airport is located;

WHEREAS, the airport building to the City of Albany is not within the corporate limits of said city but is located in Linn County, Oregon, and the said Linn County, Oregon by its County Court has agreed to join with the City in a proposed joint Airport Zoning Board,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a joint Airport Zoning Board is hereby created with the County of Linn, State of Oregon; that such joint Airport Zoning Board shall and is hereby granted the same power to adopt, administer and enforce airport zoning regulations applicable to the airport hazard area surrounding the airport of the City of Albany, Oregon as might be vested in the City of Albany; that such joint Board shall be created with five (5) members, two (2) of which shall be appointed by the City of Albany by and through its Common Council and two (2) of which shall be appointed by the County of Linn, State of Oregon, by and through its County Court and the fifth member who shall be the Chairman shall be elected and selected by a majority of the members appointed by the two political subdivisions.

The members of the Board shall be appointed and take office for five (5) years or until such time as their successors are appointed.

Section 2. Such joint Airport Zoning Board shall have all the powers and may act in accordance with the provisions of Oregon Laws, more especially Chapter 542, Oregon Laws 1947, and all laws supplemental and amendatory thereto.
