

ORDINANCE NO. 2489

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH H. G. CARL CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE PURPOSES OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE MAPLE STREET PUMPING STATION AND THE MAPLE STREET-TAKENA STREET INTERCEPTOR SEWER.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany directed the consulting engineers of Cornell, Howland, Hayes & Merryfield and the City Recorder to prepare and advertise for bids for the construction of the Maple Street Pumping Station and the Maple Street-Takena Street Interceptor Sewer, and

WHEREAS, the advertisements for bids were published in accordance with law and the bids were received and publically opened at a regular Council meeting on the 24th day of June, 1953, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany at the said meeting did, by motion duly seconded and passed, accept the recommendations of the consulting Engineers aforesaid and award the construction of the Maple Street Pumping Station and the Maple Street-Takena Street Interceptor Sewer to H. G. CARL CONSTRUCTION COMPANY.


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with H. G. CARL CONSTRUCTION COMPANY for the construction of the Maple Street Pumping Station and The Maple Street-Takena Street Interceptor Sewer, more particularly set forth in the Plans and Specifications heretofore filed with the City Recorder by the Engineers aforesaid, in the sum of \$41,477.05, and the terms thereof shall be substantially the same as set forth in the said plans and specifications for the CONSTRUCTION OF THE MAPLE STREET PUMPING STATION AND THE MAPLE STREET-TAKENA STREET INTERCEPTOR SEWER, above mentioned, with the pumps specified as "PEERLESS" therein.



In as much as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany in that construction should be commenced at as early a date as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
