

ORDINANCE NO. 2634

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO JOE GABBERT THE RIGHT, PRIVILEGE AND FRANCHISE TO OPERATE PUBLIC CARRIER BUSES WITHIN THE CITY AND PROVIDING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE FRANCHISE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: There is hereby granted to Joe Gabbert from January 1, 1956, to December 31, 1960, the right, privilege and franchise to operate public carrier busses within the City of Albany, subject to the terms herein contained.

Section 2: The Council retains the right to approve time schedules, routes, stops and fares. The Council retains the right to prescribe such additional rules and regulations.

Section 3: All busses operated under this franchise shall be of modern type and in good operating condition.

Section 4: The grantee of this franchise shall pay to the City an annual license fee of \$75.00, payable in advance on the second day of each year during the terms of this franchise.


Section 5: This franchise shall not be assigned without consent of the Council.

Section 6: The Council retains the right to cancel this franchise for any willful violation of the terms hereof.

Section 7: The necessity of public transportation is of concern to the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Albany, therefore, an emergency is declared and this ordinance shall be immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


