

ORDINANCE NO. 2675

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR JANITORIAL SERVICE FOR THE CITY HALL WITH THE B & B JANITORIAL & WINDOW SERVICE, PACIFIC BUILDING, SALEM, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany do, by the passage of this Ordinance, deem it impracticable to obtain bids for janitorial service for the City Hall.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for janitorial service for the Albany City Hall with the B & B Janitorial And Window Service, Pacific Building, Salem, Oregon.

Section 3: Inasmuch as the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
