

ORDINANCE NO. 2687

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CLEANING THE DRAINAGE DITCH FROM HIGHWAY 99E TO OAK CREEK WITH O. L. BOWMAN SAND & GRAVEL OF ALBANY, OREGON, IN A SUM NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1000.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, do, by the passage of this ordinance, deem it impracticable to call for bids for the cleaning of the ditch, easement for which may be found in Volume 159, Page 174, Linn County Deed Records, from Highway 99E to Oak Creek.

Section 2: The Mayor and City Manager are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the cleaning of the drainage ditch described in said Volume 159, Page 174, Linn County Deed Records, from Highway 99E to Oak Creek, with O. L. Bowman Sand & Gravel Company of Albany, Oregon, at a cost not to exceed the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00).

Section 3: The Council, by this ordinance, does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.


Section 4: Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon.
