

ORDINANCE NO. 2626

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A SINKING FUND FOR THE RECEIPT OF DONATIONS AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE LIBRARY AND ESTABLISH USE OF FUND FOR PURCHASE OF MEMORIAL BOOKS AS SELECTED BY LIBRARIAN OR LIBRARY BOARD.


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the people of the City of Albany that a special Sinking Fund be created to receive monies which have been donated to the Library and provide for expenditure of same, now therefore

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

There is hereby created a fund which shall be known as "A Sinking Fund for Donations to Library for Memorial Books" for the purpose of receiving monies and making expenditures therefrom which shall be used for the purchase of Memorial Books to be selected by the Librarian or the Library Board.
