

ORDINANCE NO. 2909

TITLE: An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2847, being an Ordinance granting to Albany Bus Service, herein referred to as grantee, the right and privilege to operate busses upon the streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, providing for the filing of schedules of rates and routes, providing for the placement of bus stop signs; requiring the carrying of liability insurance against personal injury and property damage, and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2847 be and it is hereby amended to read as follows: "There is hereby granted by the City of Albany to Lester C. Knofler, doing business as Albany Bus Service, the right and privilege to operate busses for the carrying of passengers upon the streets and public ways within the City of Albany."

Section 2:

Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and it will become effective immediately upon the passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
