

ORDINANCE NO. 2934

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE WESTERLY 8 FEET OF UMATILLA STREET BETWEEN 5TH AVENUE AND 7TH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by the adoption of Resolution No. 614 at the Council meeting held on the 14th day of December, 1960, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. o'clock on January 11, 1961 as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Umatilla Street, more particularly described in the said resolution and did in the said resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said resolution, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 11th day of January, 1961 was duly held and parties were given opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a portion of Umatilla Street, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Riverside Cemetery which place of beginning is Southwesterly 66 feet along the Northerly boundary line of 7th Ave. from the Southwest corner of Block 41, City of Albany; thence Northwesterly along the Easterly boundary of said Riverside Cemetery a distance of 445 feet to the Northeast corner of said Riverside Cemetery; thence Northeasterly parallel with the Northerly boundary line of said 7th Ave. a distance of 8 feet; thence Southeasterly, parallel with the Easterly boundary line of said Riverside Cemetery a distance of 445 feet to the Northerly boundary line of said 7th Ave.; thence Southwesterly 8 feet to the place of beginning, all being within the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon,

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Oregon.
