

ORDINANCE NO. 3121

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A METHOD OF ACCOUNTING FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: CASH METHOD OF ACCOUNTING ADOPTED

The cash method of accounting for receipts and expenditures for the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby adopted.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety for the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and it will become effective immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
