

ORDINANCE NO. 3182

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 2984 as amended by Ordinance No. 3165, by providing for materials required in signs on existing nonconforming buildings and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 3165

Ordinance No. 3165 amending a portion of Ordinance No. 2984 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: ADDITION OF SECTION 29

Ordinance No. 2984 is amended by the addition of Section 29 thereto to read as follows:

"Section 29: MATERIALS REQUIRED IN GROUND SIGNS AND WALL SIGNS. Notwithstanding the provisions contained in Section 19 and 20 of this Ordinance setting forth materials required in the construction of ground signs and wall signs, all wall signs and ground signs for which a permit is required under this Ordinance shall have a surface or facing of incombustible material, provided, however, that nonilluminated combustible letters may be used on existing nonconforming buildings, as such buildings are defined in Ordinance No. 2916 and in the Uniform Building Code adopted by the city; further, nonilluminated combustible structural trim may be used on the same type of building. When, in the opinion of the Building Inspector, nonilluminated combustible letters will not add to the fire hazard of a ground sign, then and in that event said nonilluminated combustible letters may be used on new or existing ground signs.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Inasmuch as the immediate passage of this Ordinance is necessary to the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
