

ORDINANCE NO. 3424

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING AN AREA ADJACENT TO SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD TRACKS AND NORTH SIDE OF WEST 34TH AVENUE, TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of May, 1969, at a regular Council meeting the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 3414 wherein it was provided that a public hearing would be held on the 11th day of June, 1969, concerning the advisability of annexing an area adjacent to Southern Pacific Railroad tracks and North side of West 34th Avenue, to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon,

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 11th day of June, 1969, and at that time the Council determined that the Notices of Hearing had been given as provided in the said Ordinance, and pursuant to the terms of ORS 222.111, 222.120 and 222.170, and

WHEREAS, the Council, after said hearing determined that this area adjacent to Southern Pacific Railroad tracks and north side of West 34th Avenue, be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners having been filed giving their consent to the annexation,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and is hereby annexed to the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit:

Beg at SW cor DLC 53, T 11 S R 3W; th Nly to CL Albany Santiam Canal; th N 17°30' E 7.1 ch; th Wly to E li SPRR main r/w; th Sly to S li DLC 53; th Ely to beg. Exc pt in roads and railroad r/w. Also exc, 11 3W 18C 101 described in Book 298, page 587, belonging to SPRR, Linn Co., Or.

As a M-3 zone.


Section 2: That a copy of this ordinance shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and the number of the ordinance shall be noted on the official zoning map of the City of Albany.

Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

WHEREAS, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and should the same be annexed, that the city facilities be made available to this property, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
