

ORDINANCE NO. 3692

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A 6' PEDESTRIAN RIGHT-OF-WAY LOCATED BETWEEN 36TH COURT AND 35TH AVENUE AND NORTH OF 38TH AVENUE SUCH VACATION SUBJECT TO RESERVING THE ORIGINAL 6' SIDEWALK ALIGNMENT FOR STORM DRAIN LINE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1477, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 24th day of January 1973, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 28th day of February, 1973, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a 6' pedestrian right-of-way located between 36th Court and 35th Avenue and north of 38th Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 28th day of February, 1973, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a 6' pedestrian right-of-way located between 36th Court and 35th Avenue and north of 38th Avenue in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated reserving a right-of-way for storm sewer.
