

ORDINANCE NO. 3706

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A 50' RIGHT-OF-WAY, 18TH AVENUE BETWEEN WASHINGTON AND FERRY, SUCH VACATION SUBJECT TO RESERVING A SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT OF 20 FEET TOTAL - 10 FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF THE SANITARY TRUNK LINE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1497, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 11th day of April, 1973, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 9th day of May, 1973, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of 18th Avenue right-of-way between Washington and Ferry Streets,

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 9th day of May, 1973, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a 50' right-of-way, 18th Avenue between Washington and Ferry Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated reserving a sanitary sewer easement of 20 feet total - 10 feet on either side of the center line of the sanitary trunk line.
