AN ORDINANCE VACATING A 16' STRIP OF RIGHT OF WAY ALONG THE ENTIRE WEST SIDE OF FERRY STREET FROM THE NORTH LINE OF QUEEN AVENUE TO THE SOUTHERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1763, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 10th day of March, 1976, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 14th day of April, 1976, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of

16' strip of right of way along the entire west side of Ferry Street from the north line of Queen Avenue to the southerly right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad.

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 14th day of April, 1976, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

That a 16' strip of right of way along the entire west side of Ferry Street from the north line of Queen Avenue to the southerly right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad be vacated subject to the following conditions:

1. That the adjoining property owners shall sign a petition for improvements and waiver of remonstrance.
2. The entire vacated right-of-way area shall be retained by the City as a utility easement.
