

ORDINANCE NO. 4497

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Chapter 7.72 of the Albany Municipal Code by the addition of Section 7.72.040 making it unlawful to assault a public safety officer.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 7.72 of the Albany Municipal Code is amended by the addition of Section 7.72.040 to read as follows:

"Section 7.72.040. Assaulting a Public Safety Officer.


(1) A person commits the crime of assaulting a public safety officer if the person intentionally or knowingly causes physical injury to another person, knowing the other person to be a peace officer, corrections officer, or firefighter, and while such other person is acting in the course of official duty.

(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Albany Municipal Code, a person convicted of assaulting a public safety officer shall be sentenced to not less than 7 days of imprisonment and shall not be granted bench parole, probation or suspension of sentence before serving at least 7 days of the sentence."


