

ORDINANCE NO. 4513

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A PERMIT FOR THE USE OF CITY SIDEWALKS FOR A MOBILE VENDING FOOD CART AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR A REVIEW OF THE PERMIT IN SIX MONTHS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 7.68, it is hereby granted to Karen Bellamy, Bellamy Cookie Company, 320 6th Avenue SW, Albany, OR 97321, a permit for the use of city sidewalks to operate a mobile food vending cart. This permit limits the use of the sidewalk to a distance of three feet from the face of an existing building or street curb and is limited to the following locations:

1st Avenue & Broadalbin	2nd Avenue & Broadalbin
1st Avenue & Ellsworth	2nd Avenue & Ellsworth
1st Avenue & Ferry	2nd Avenue & Ferry
1st Avenue & Lyons	2nd Avenue & Lyons
3rd Avenue & Broadalbin	6th & Jackson


Section 2. This permit shall be reviewed by the City Council six months after the effective date and unless specifically renewed at that time the permit herein granted shall terminate seven months from its effective date.

Section 3: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
