

ORDINANCE NO. 4905

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 7.84.110, VEGETATION OVER FIFTEEN INCHES HIGH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Albany Municipal Code Section 7.84.110, Vegetation Over Fifteen Inches High, is hereby amended to read as follows:


7.84.110 Vegetation over fifteen inches high. No owner of real property in the City shall allow to remain on his property **within fifty feet of a public right-of-way, railroad right-of-way, private road, or ~~within fifty feet of~~** any structure including a combustible fence or any weeds, grass, or other noxious vegetation over fifteen inches in height unless such is determined not to be a fire hazard by the Fire Chief or his designee. Such weeds, grass, or other noxious vegetation may be cut by the City as provided by Section 7.84.130.

Section 2: Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
