

ORDINANCE NO. 4927

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE 6.18.060, DANGEROUS DOGS, INFRACTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Albany Municipal Code 6.18.060, Dangerous Dogs, Infractions, is hereby amended to read as follows:


6.18.060 Infraction Penalty. The violation of any provision of this ordinance chapter shall be punishable ~~constitute an infraction subject to the procedures set forth at AMC 1.05~~ and subject to the penalties set forth in AMC Chapter 1.04. In addition to these penalties, the Municipal Court Judge may order the dog in question euthanized if the Judge finds that the owner of the dog has failed to comply with any of the requirements of this chapter after having received notification that the dog in question has been classified as a dangerous or potentially dangerous dog.

Section 2. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
