


RESOLUTION 94

WHEREAS, the council of the City of Albany heretofore did authorize the preparation of plans and specifications covering the construction of a drainage channel around the Albany Municipal Airport property;

WHEREAS plans and specifications have been submitted and the estimate of cost has been given by the engineer as being \$22,000.00;

WHEREAS such cost is to be contributed 56.02% by the Federal Government through the Civil Aeronautics Administration and the balance to be paid by the City of Albany, Oregon,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the plans and specifications so submitted by G. C. McKinney, the engineer, covering the construction of the drainage channel around the south end of the Albany Municipal Airport be accepted and approved, that the construction of the city's drainage channel shall be commenced as soon as possible and the City Recorder is hereby directed to prepare invitations for bids for the construction of this work based on the plans and specifications and shall be made available to the prospective bidders, and that notice shall be given in the Albany Democrat-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Albany, Oregon for two successive weeks and that such bids shall be received up to 2:00 P.M. in the afternoon of September 9th, 1949; that said notice shall require the bidder to qualify as is required by law and to give necessary bond for faithful performance and that the city shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.
