

RESOLUTION NO. 672

ADOPTION OF ENGINEER'S REPORT AND AUTHORIZATION FOR MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY FOR ERECTION OF METAL STREET LIGHT STANDARDS ON 25th AVENUE BETWEEN LIBERTY AND UMATILLA STS.


WHEREAS certain property owners have petitioned for the erection of special standards for street lights to be installed and have requested bonding privileges as specified by the Bancroft Bonding Act of the State of Oregon, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Power & Light Company has agreed to furnish such standards on a contractual basis and have determined the cost thereof,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the report of the City Engineer filed with the City Recorder on the 15th day of December, 1961, concerning erection of metal standards for street lights on 25th Avenue between Liberty and Umatilla Streets be and same is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorize the Mayor and City Manager to sign contracts on behalf of the City of Albany with Pacific Power & Light Company for the purpose of erecting metal standards for street lights with the cost thereof to be assessed against the benefited property.
